People Inc. announced The Museum of disABILITY History located on Main St. in Buffalo will not be reopening. The organization says like many museums around the country, a lack of dedicated funding has made operations unsustainable.

Open for the past 22 years, People Inc. has identified alternative outlets and partners to preserve the historical artifacts and collections.
