iCan Bike Camp
JULY 15th-19th, 2024
at The R.O.C.K.
425 Meyer Rd. West Seneca, NY



iCan Bike Camp uses adapted bicycles, a specialized instructional program, and trained staff to enable individuals with disabilities to learn to ride a two-wheeled bicycle.

Riders attend one 75 minute session each day for five consecutive days where they learn to ride while accompanied and encouraged by volunteer. Over the course of the week, we continually adjust the bikes in an effort to challenge riders appropriately as they gradually discover the skill and joy of riding.

Each athlete will select a session time and attend camp during the same session each day, Monday through Friday. Some Sessions are already full. They will be removed off the registration for when they reach capacity. To register, go to:
